Introduction to Methodology for Societal Complexity:

Complex societal problems are difficult to handle because of their complexity. They need a multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary approach. A combination of qualitative and quantitative methods is needed to analyze these complex societal problems and to make sustainable decisions.

In the course the main ideas of the theory for handling complex societal problems will be explained with an introduction to the methodology COMPRAM (Complex Problem Handling Method, DeTombe, 1994; 2015).

Questions posed are: What are complex societal problems? What have the different complex societal problems in common? What is the reason these problems need a multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary approach? Why should these kind of problems be handled in co-operation with groups of experts and actors? What are the basic approaches for complex societal problems? What is the role of knowledge, power and emotion in handling complex societal problems? What combination of qualitative and quantitative methods are needed to handle these problems?

The Compram methodology can be applied to all kind of complex problems a business or a country is confronted with. Complex problems like finding new markets, answering new demands, immigration problems, changes due to politics, transport challenges, sustainable development, healthcare, education and global safety.

The Compram methodology is developed by DeTombe (1994-2019). The Compram methodology is a scientific methodology for handling

complex societal problems in a democratic, transparent and structured way. Handling means policymaking: analyzing, decision making, guiding and evaluating interventions. The Compram methodology focuses on the whole spectrum of the problem handling process. The OECD advised to handle Global Safety according to the guidelines of the Compram Methodology (2006). The Compram methodology is used in all continents and on many kind of complex societal problems.
